## Nunavut Literacy Week 2005

The Nunavut Literacy Council is pleased to present Nunavummiut with 10 Activity Sheets for Children. The artist who created these activities is Cyndi Foster, formerly of Cambridge Bay.

You are welcome to make copies of these Activity Sheets and use them in your programs or classes or distribute them to families so parents and children can enjoy the activities together.

Most of the sheets can be used as a colouring book, but there are also other activities suggested for some of the pages. Here's a list of the subjects and activities in the **Nunavut Literacy Week 2005's *Activity Sheets for Children***:

- ◆ **Spot the differences:** Compare the two pictures on the page and point out the things that are different. Colour the picture.
- ◆ **Musk Ox Trace:** Trace the other half of the musk ox and colour the picture.
- ◆ **Dog Harnessing:** Colour the picture and add your own details.
- ◆ **Inukshuk Puzzle:** Cut out the pieces and make an inukshuk.
- ◆ **Maze:** Find your way through the maze and colour the picture.
- ◆ **Skidoo:** Connect the dots to make a skidoo. This involves recognizing numbers and counting.
- ◆ **Iglu:** Write a story and colour the picture.
- ◆ **Owl:** Cut out the pieces and make an owl.
- ◆ **Sled Building:** Colour the picture and add your own details.
- ◆ **Cake Walk:** Colour the picture and put the numbers in correct order.
